Fences

This information applies to fences, walls, hedges, or shrubs on a property within the Town of Lumsden.

## Do I need a Development or Building Permit to build a fence?

No, fences do not require any permits prior to construction.

Please see the Town of Lumsden Zoning Bylaw No. 15, 2002 to find a property's zoning district.

## Are there height restrictions for fences?

Fence heights are specific to zoning districts. The maximum fence heights in various districts are:

| Zoning District Type | Maximum fence height (metres) |  | *may be extended to 2 metres if fence is to keep out wildlife, and transparent materials are used e.g. chain link, deer fence, etc. |
| :---: | :---: | :---: | :---: |
|  | Side and rear yards | Front yards |  |
| Residential | 2.0 | 1.22* |  |
| Commercial, Industrial, |  |  |  |
| Institutional, Other | 2.5 | 2.5 |  |

## Can I build a fence on a corner lot?

Fences are permitted on corner sites however, no fence may be placed to limit vision in an established intersection site triangle (Figure 1).

## Is the Town of Lumsden involved in shared fence issues?

Disputes relating to fence construction, maintenance, or cost are under Provincial jurisdiction. If neighbours wish to have a government third-party, fence-sharing issues may be resolved through civil court.
